#### **Duke Island Park.**

**General Information:** Located in Bridgewater Township, Duke Island Park is a site of rich natural beauty which offers varied recreational experiences. Truly an "island" park, it is traversed by the historic Raritan Power Canal. The Somerset County Park Commission acquired this **339 acre site** in 1958, and has developed it to provide a wide variety of active and passive recreational opportunities and special events for park visitors.



**Visitors Center:** The Visitors Center is located near the main parking area, and houses the Park Ranger office and **real rest room facilities**. Rangers are available for information on the park recreation activities, and brochures and maps of the Park Commission facilities are available.

**Picnic Areas:** Duke Island Park offers five picnic areas, available by reservation for groups of 20 people or more. Each of Picnic these picnic groves has at least 12 tables and 8 grills. A larger picnic area, which features a pavilion and a softball field, can accommodate groups up to 250 people. Additional picnic tables line the picturesque

river trail, and are available on a casual basis. Among these is a fully accessible area, with a paved path, concrete patio, and tables to accommodate wheelchair seating.

Playgrounds: There are both pre-school and older children's playground facilities adjacent to the play and picnic areas.

Athletics and Sports Opportunities: Two softball fields are available by permit for leagues and tournaments. When not reserved for this use, the fields are available for those who wish to practice or have a friendly pickup game. The Raritan River is stocked by the New Jersey Department of Fish, Game, and Wildlife, and offers prime fishing locations for beginner and expert anglers. Hikers, walkers, and bird watchers may take advantage of the trails which follow along the river and pass through the extensive wooded areas.



Walking and Bike Trails: Three and a half miles of picturesque trails await walkers, joggers and bikers along both the canal and the Raritan River.

**Shopping:** Spouses may avail themselves at the nearby renowned Bridgewater Commons Mall with hundreds of shops and Historic Somerville with its quaint shops and numerous excellent restaurants.

#### **Directions**



**From Northern NJ:** NJ Turnpike south to I-78 west to Exit 29, I-287 south to Exit 17, Rt 202 south to Milltown Rd south to end and left on Old York Rd to right into the park.

**From Southern NJ:** NJ Turnpike north to Exit 10, I-287 north to Exit 14, Rt 22 west to Rt 202 south. Follow Northern NJ directions.

From Manhattan: Holland Tunnel to I-78. Follow Northern NJ directions.

**From Brooklyn and Staten Island:** Verrazano Bridge to I-278 to Rt 440 south to Outerbridge Crossing. I-287 north to Exit 14, Rt 22 west to Rt 202 south. Follow Northern NJ directions.
